Oregon's Top Catholic Exhorts Foreign Nationals, Here Illegally, To Vote In Nov. 4 Election

Portland, OR (USA) -- Is Oregon's top Catholic, Archbishop Alexander K. Sample, attempting to corrupt a U.S. election by stuffing the ballot box with thousands of votes of foreign nationals -illegal aliens- in his archdiocese?

We citizens (this Catholic among them) will post our ballots before 8 pm tomorrow... but we won't be alone. We'll be mirrored by as many as 100,000 Catholic parishioners-who came into the U.S.A. and to Oregon illegally-who will also cast their ballots as they have been exhorted to do by their spiritual leader, Archbishop Sample. My "No" vote on Measure 88 will most certainly be nullified by the "Yes" vote of an illegal alien...which is apparently just what Archbishop Sample has in mind.

At issue is Measure-88, a referendum on an Oregon law that would permit a "driver card" to be issued "without requiring (the recipient to provide) proof of legal presence in the United States."

Archbishop Sample, of the Archdiocese of Portland Oregon, is urging his Spanish -speaking parishioners to vote "Yes on M-88" via the pages of his official, Spanish language publication - EL CENTINELA.

So who, precisely, makes up this targeted demographic Archbishop Sample is pushing to vote for Measure - 88. Well, voila, the precise same demographic that will benefit from it. Those who are in this country illegally -and can't prove otherwise- will have a chance to cast a vote on a law that will make them 'street legal.' What's not to like?

The Pew Hispanic Center reckons that roughly 4%, or about 157,200 of Oregon's tiny 3,930,000 population, are here illegally. The OREGONIAN newspaper estimates that approximately 85 percent of those, or about 133,620 of that number, are Mexican nationals.

Archbishop Sample himself estimates that 80,000 of his parishioners will suffer if the tendered 'driver card' law is not ratified by "the voters." Professor Richard LaMountain, in a letter to The CATHOLIC SENTINEL placed the number of 'illegals' working in Oregon at 120,000 and the number of U.S. citizens in Oregon either not working or underemployed at 200,000.

But neither Archbishop Sample, nor anyone else in the Catholic hierarchy here, has published any study to calibrate the impact of illegal labor on wages or employment of Oregonians legally here.

Plus or minus 100,000 Mexican parishioners, in the USA (Oregon) illegally, are being urged by their spiritual leader, Archbishop Sample, to vote for a state driver's license specifically tailored to meet their one binding commonality; illegal presence in the U.S.A.

But wait. It is illegal for a non-citizen to vote in a U.S. election. Does the Archbishop know this? Does he know that once the ballot is in the hands of his faithful, on this election eve, those aliens can vote on every item on the ballot menu to include contests for a U.S. Senator, U.S. Congressman, and Oregon governor? Does he care?

Sample's gigantic

archdiocese extends south to California, north to Washington State and west to the Pacific Ocean. Those illegally present have either crossed the U.S.A.'s Southern border or simply overstayed their Visa deadline.

This journalist, a Catholic in the archdiocese,-began to sense there was a large piece missing when the Archdiocese began its 'get out the vote' push.

I discovered Portland's Archdiocese is preaching a double narrative. A traditional narrative is delivered via the 144 year old CATHOLIC SENTINEL but a second, very different "Social Justice" narrative is delivered via EL CENTINELA, which champions those here illegally while urging them to vote in this U.S. election. (And the same Oct. 16 issue of EL CENTINELA devoted five pages to the validation of a convicted drug trafficker-Francisco Aguirre- who has been given 'sanctuary' in an area Lutheran church to avoid deportation.)

I'm sure Archbishop Sample must know Oregon's worst kept secret...that even a squirrel can vote in Oregon and his new fake citizenship, or even his tree trunk address, will never, ever, be verified. Just a few weeks after mailing in his voter registration card every applicant will thereafter be sent ballots for every election...forever. No questions asked. It's as easy as filling in the form and dropping it in a mailbox.

Many foreign nationals already do vote here in every election and have for years. How many, no one knows, because the powers that be don't want to know themselves.

Step ONE to becoming a Voter in Oregon ... is to become a "citizen."

No problem. Simply smudge a pencil mark in a tiny oval, fill in a name and address, and you will soon be voting in every election...forever.
